What is Stuff the Bus Book Drive? Stuff the Bus Book Drive is United Way of the National Capital Area's annual call on the community to help provide NEW books to ensure low-income middle school students have access to the grade-appropriate books they need to advance their reading skills and improve academic outcomes.



#### O: When is the book drive?

A: Stuff the Bus Book Drive is scheduled for January 2 - January 31, 2020.

### Q: How many books are needed?

A: The 2020 book drive goal is 5,000 NEW books.

#### O: Can I donate used books?

A: United Way NCA works with our community schools across the region to access the needs of the school and the students. To meet their needs and provide the much needed resources, the book drive focuses on collecting new books.

#### Q: How can I participate in the book drive?

#### Q: How much are the books?

A: On average, book prices range between \$6.00 - \$15.00 per book. For as little as \$30 you can supply 5 students with a new book.
