

#Count DMV In for the 2020 Census COVID-19 Updates for Census Operations

Our community's participation in the 2020 Census is more important than ever. The census data collection period has been confirmed to end on **September 30, 2020**.

Census Takers are now visiting households that have not self-responded to the census and will be doing so until September 30. However, individuals can still complete the census on their own from home and in multiple languages online (<http://my2020census.gov>), by phone (844-330-2020), and by mail ([mailed](#) paper forms arrived late April). Anyone who responds on their own will not receive a knock on the door.

CENSUS TIMELINE

All census operational plans are reflected on this [page](#).

- **Self-Response Period:** ongoing through September 30, 2020, but please message to community members that they should complete the census ASAP. The online/phone/mail self-response option is available throughout the entire NRFU operation.
- **Non-Response Follow Up (NRFU):** August 11 – September 30 (note this is just the operational range the Census Bureau has provided; they may finish earlier than September 30 which is why we are encouraging a timely self-response.)
- Special enumeration operations such as Group Quarters (GQ), Service-Based (SBE), Transitory Locations (TL), and Targeted Non-Shelter Locations (TNSOL) have all been scheduled to be completed by the end of September.

NON-RESPONSE FOLLOW UP

What to know about Census Takers:*

- They must carry a photo ID badge with a U.S. Department of Commerce watermark and expiration date. They will be carrying an iPhone to use for enumeration.
- Census Takers will ONLY ask questions that appear on the census form. They will NEVER ask to enter your home.
- They will never ask you about your finances, citizenship or immigration status, driver's license, or social security number.
- It is against the law for them to share your answers with anyone, including your landlord, employer, police, or any other government agency.
