The 2023 event will be held in October, providing essential services and resources to the region's ALICE (Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed) population in Washington, DC and surrounding counties in Maryland and Northern Virginia. ALICE represents nearly 500,000 households and approximately 1.3 million individuals in the National Capital Area that earn more than the Federal Poverty Level but less than the basic cost of living for the county/state in which they live.

United Way NCA brings together local service providers and critical resources to meet medical, housing and employment needs, as well as much more - serving over 1,500 PCC participants to date.
